





COACHES AND SECURITY

- · Maximum of two coaches per lifter
- List the name of your coach(es) on your entry form
- All coaches must be current World Powerlifting members and accredited by your national federation
- World Powerlifting dress code applies to coaches (tracksuit or sport shorts, a WP approved t-shirt and sports shoes)
- Security passes will be issued to all lifters, nominated coaches and referees
- Only those with passes will be permitted in the warm-up area
- All lifters, coaches and official passes will allow entry of the holder access to watch all sessions


